



# Brisbane International Schools Challenge

## Hot Shots Red Level

### What is it?

The Brisbane International Schools Challenge is an opportunity to represent your school in a fun tennis team and play against other local schools in your area. The format is based on Tennis Australia's ANZ Tennis Hot Shots program - Hot Shots is "modified tennis" which is easier for kids to play. The Hot Shots Red competition is open to all children in grades of 1 – 3.

For the first four weeks of play, teams will **compete at Pure Tennis Ferny Hills** before participating in the **Regional Finals at the Queensland Tennis Centre** in Tennyson on Sunday the 7<sup>th</sup> of December. All children who play for their school team will get to participate in the Regional Finals! The winners and runners up of the Regional Finals will then go on to play the **Grand Finals at the Brisbane International** along with pupils from over twenty other schools!

### When will my child compete in the school tennis team?

All selected players who register online will represent their school by competing against the other school teams at Pure Tennis Ferny Hills over four Saturdays of fun competition! Where possible, we will select reserve players and organise a rotational roster so you do not have to commit to all four Saturdays. Please see overleaf for dates & times.

### What happens in the finals?

Each school will play each other once, culminating in a Gala Style Regional Finals day where the top two schools over the course of the event will play off for the title. All school teams play on the Regional Finals day.

### What does my child need to wear & bring to the competition days?

Pupils selected to represent the school tennis team are to wear their school sports uniform & hat when competing each Saturday. Racquets will be provided for pupils who need one.
